1. Submit Your Background Check

Stop by the Administrative Office or send a scanned photo of your Valid ID driver's license or state Id or passport. Processing may take up to 2 weeks.

2. Register Online

Visit https://volunteer.usawest.org to create an account, choose your volunteer area, and complete your profile.

3. Complete PTM Training

- Finish the courses and download your certificate(s)

- If you are a returning volunteer, then please log back in and apply for the area you are interested in and follow the prompt and required training course(s).

4. Upload Certificates




STEPS BELOW FOR CREATING YOUR VOLUNTEER ACCOUNT AND REQUIRED COURSES TO TAKE.

Step 1: Register or login at:




Step 2: Enter your zip code or address
