To get started, please follow these steps:

1. **Register Online:** Visit <https://volunteer.usawest.org> to create an account, search zip code 80909 and choose the opportunity you would like to volunteer for.
2. **Complete Protect The Mission (PTM) Training for your location (See back side for Online Training Steps for the highlighted section):**
 - Create an account at Praesidium Academy
 - Finish the courses and upload it in order to download your certificate(s) to send to me.
 - You can use a smart Phone or Tablet if you do not have a computer.
 - Be prepared to schedule for onboarding as this will take an hour of your time. This is only done at our Yuma Corps.
3. **Upload/Email/hand deliver your Certificates:** Once you have completed your training, upload your certificates to your volunteer account and email me your certificates. If you have trouble emailing your certs, please bring them to me the day you come for your scheduled onboarding.
4. **Onboarding:** A Background check will need to be done since you will be doing more than 40 hours per year. Please bring a non-expired valid ID driver's license, State Id or Passport on your scheduled day for onboarding. There will be paperwork to fill and get your ID badge that will have your first name and last initial. This is mandatory for you to wear during your time volunteering.
5. **Availability:** Availability is subject to change. Please be patient, as certain volunteer locations may require additional permission and onboarding schedules may vary.
